## Fifth Graders Enjoy a Renaissance STEAM Fair

On November 8th, eighty 5th graders from Accident and Bel Air Elementary schools were part of a larger group of visiting students who traveled to Frostburg State University to watch The Mixed-Up Files of Mrs. Basil E. Frankweiler, a play about children who hide in a museum to solve the mystery of a statue that may have been carved by Michelangelo during the Renaissance era. After the play, the students participated in a Renaissance STEAM Fair (science, technology, engineering, arts, and math), sponsored in part by the Allegany Arts Council, the Frostburg State University Foundation, and the Evergreen Heritage Center (EHC) Foundation.

During the event, the students participated in a dance improv session of hiding in a museum like the one in the play that was conducted by Mountain City Center for the Arts. Students were also taught by EHC instructors how Renaissance artists created paint from eggs and ground-up minerals (photo below). Students also learned about inventions developed during the Renaissance and then had the opportunity to develop their own inventions.

## **EHC Fall Programs Span Pre-K to Grade 12**

In 2017-18, the Evergreen Heritage Center (EHC) Foundation and its partners continue to provide programs for pre-K children participating in either Head Start or Judy Center programs, Kindergarten students at three Title I schools (with a high percentage of disadvantaged children), as well as middle school and high school students attending 6th grade, 8th grade, high school Earth Science, high school Biology, and/or After School programs.
