Flash Camp!

What is Flash Camp? Join us on **Sunday June 9**th **from 1-3 pm** for this **free event** for parents and their children where everyone can participate in two hours of fun hands-on art, science, and grow it/cook it camp activities. All participants will have the opportunity to join in a variety of our camp experiences including:

- **Eco-Printing**: creating works of art using elements from the Evergreen woods, fields, and streams and then taking them home as a souvenir of your experience
- Build a Bird's Nest: building a nest that can be used in your own back yard
- **Pond Exploration**: collecting "creatures" from the Evergreen pond and then examining them under a microscope
- Recycle Rewards: using recyclable materials to create new treasures such as art work and wallets
- Garden Discovery: exploring the EHC's gardens and participating in a scavenger hunt
- Pickle Party: learning how to make pickles from the garden's cucumbers

Summer Discovery Camps!

Join us this summer in one or more of our summer discovery camps (and bring a friend). We have **new activities and experiments every summer**. Camp fees are \$150/week for Art, Science, or Grow It/Cook It. The fee for Young Naturalists Camp is \$100. We also have **scholarships available** (courtesy of the Wolfe Trust) for children qualifying for USDA's Free and Reduced Meal program.

This summer's camp schedule is as follows:

Arts in the Outdoors (June 24-29, 9-3 pm): This camp for children entering grades 3-7 enables campers to explore their own creativity with nature as the theme. Campers will draw, painting, used mixed media, do printmaking, paper making, sculpture, and writing, while finding inspiration in the great outdoors and learning about the work of environmental writers and artists.

Science Discovery (July 8-12, 9-3 pm): This camp for children entering grades 3-7 encourages campers to explore EHC forests, fields, and wetlands by using cool science tools to learn about plants and animals and the world we live in. Campers conduct real science experiments, learn how to live green, and participate in fun science challenges.

Young Naturalists (July 15-19, 9-1 pm): This camp for children entering grades 1-3 provides campers with the opportunity to uncover the secrets of mini-beasts, plants with armor, and stealth camouflage in Evergreen's lush backyard habitats. This half-day camp for our youngest group of campers includes hands-on close encounters with wildlife and science.

Grow It, Cook It (July 22-16, 9-3 pm): This camp for children entering grades 3-7 provides campers with the opportunity to start seeds and harvest fruits and veggies from EHC gardens, greenhouses, and orchards. Campers will learn where our food comes from, how it grows, and then makes the journey from farm to table as they investigate garden secrets, experiment with plants, and prepare simple delicious snacks from our farm.

Garden Workshops!

Join us for our new spring/summer garden workshops. These 90-minute workshops are offered for a registration fee of \$15 that can be applied toward the purchase of EHC plants and herbs.

Gardening 101 (Sunday, June 23rd 1-2:30 pm) - Learn about the basics of backyard gardening, including site selection, soil tests and amendments, choosing plants and varieties, pros and cons of raised bed gardening. Go home with a vegetable plant seedling of your choice.

Native Plants 101 (Sunday July 28th 1-2:30 pm) - Learn about native plants common to this area and how to propagate them, including seed stratification and scarification. Also, learn about the benefits of adding native plants to your garden/landscape and the environmental, ecological and medicinal benefits of various plants. Go home with a native plant.
