ITS INS AND OUTS**

TAKE A HIKE

The Forest Evolution Trail System consists of just over 5 miles of trail across the Evergreen Heritage Center Foundation Property. Step back in time as you visit old growth trees, historic stone walls, and the remnants of coal mining on the property.

OUR TRAILS

BLACK TRAIL – COAL TRAIL

Easy | 0.63 miles

Follow the historic Coal Trail on this flat path to see how and where mining historically occurred on the Evergreen Property.

RED TRAIL

Easy to Moderate | 0.3 miles

Observe the location of our Black Cohosh plots, view the historic orchard, and watch the honey bees.

PINK TRAIL

Moderate | 0.09 miles

Cross the lower barnyard to view our chestnut tree hybrids, chestnut circle, and historic retaining wall.

GREEN TRAIL

Easy to Moderate | 0.18 miles

Take this offshoot of the Blue trail to view our Fern Bog—a unique characteristic of the property!

ORANGE TRAIL

Moderate to Difficult | 0.59 miles

This spur of the Black Trail will boast the location of our Black Cohosh plots and even a historic mine opening.

BLUE TRAIL

Moderate to Difficult | 1.22 miles

Observe proof of a mature forest with wetlands, uprooted trees, and plenty of signs of wildlife.

YELLOW TRAIL

Moderate to Difficult | 1.37 miles

A stream side trail teeming with old growth trees and warbler habitat.

WHITE TRAIL

Moderate to Difficult | 0.72 miles

Notice the many brush piles and Fern ID Garden, then enter the Forest Garden to learn how to grow under the canopy.
